## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of JOB RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-6335, a tributary of THE TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 22.34 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50740. The date of priority is MAY 17, 1988. This right is limited to NOT MORE THAN 6.6 ACRE-FEET OF STORED WATER ONLY, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 2, (SE 1/4 NW 1/4), SECTION 2, T 1 S, R 3 W, W.M.; NORTH 18 DEGREES EAST, 590 FEET FROM THE SW CORNER OF SE 1/4 NW 1/4 OF SECTION 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
