 A couple of the major POA's (Wells) have failed over the course of this permit process such that the full rate cannot be developed in the COBU. This has prompted the need to add some replacement POA's (Wells) to complete the COBU for the permit. This Permit Amendment accompanies an application for Extension of Time so that the Additional POA's can be included in the Permit and the COBU. In consultation with OWRD Staff, this appeared to be the cleanest way to complete the Claim of Beneficial Use process for the Permit G-12679 - now G-16935
