1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:

- a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs  $\div 100 ac$ ); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac=0.56 cfs).
- b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

At this point the canal bends to the west and the water flows west in the Goodman Springs Branch (Richartz Canal) approximately 1010 feet to a point where it changes to a northwesterly direction and flows approximately 2800 feet to the NE corner of the property. A pump station along the Richartz Canal on the neighboring property to the north of the subject property (705'± west and 380'± north of the NE corner of the subject property) has been used to pump irrigation water from the Richartz Canal to the property.

The pump is a 20 hp centrifugal pump. The water was pumped south from the pump station through a buried 4" pipeline to the southerly edge of the property. Two portable aluminum hand lines were used to irrigate the property. There were 24- 6 gpm sprinklers (40' spacing) on each hand line.
