*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Certificate 12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Certificate 87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:

a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).

b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

2. Add cfs for the portions of water rights on all the land included in the transfer; however do not count cfs for supplemental rights on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary right on the same land. The fee should be assessed only once for each "on the ground" acre included in the transfer. (In this example, blank 5a would be only 0.56 cfs, since both rights serve the same 45.0 acres. Blank 5b would be 0 and Line 5 would then also become 0).

The Point of Diversion (POD) relocation on the To Map is not a transfer, but is allowed under ORS 540.510(5) which authorizes the relocation of a POD as necessary to follow the movements of a naturally changing stream channel. The relocated POD is within 500 feet of the POD on record and the change does not move the POD upstream or downstream beyond the diversion of another appropriator. No fee should be attached to the POD relocation as the statute states that this type of change is not a transfer. A permit amendment application for Permit S-54707 (Application S-87531) is being concurrently filed with this transfer application. The permit amendment is contingent on approval of the transfer and vice versa. If you need additional space, continue on a separate piece of paper and attach to the application as "Attachment 1".

Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Each system consists of a 7.5 horsepower motor connected to a Berkeley pump with a 1½ inch inlet by 1 inch outlet. Each pump forwards water to a Kifko traveler with a 9/16-inch nozzle. One traveler has 700 feet of 3-inch-diameter hose and 300 feet of 2-inch-diameter hose. The second traveler has 1,100 feet of 3-inch-diameter hose and 200 feet of 2½-inch-diameter hose.
