- *Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Permit S-12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Permit S-87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:
- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each permit involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the permit (for S-12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be changed to get the application cfs (x 45 ac = 0.56 cfs).
 - b. If the water right permit does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For S-87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Add cfs for the portions of permits on all the land included in the application; however do not count cfs for supplemental permits on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary permit on the same land. Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this permit amendment; and why: A transfer application to make changes to the place of use under Certificate 20412 is being concurrently filed with this application. The proposed transfer will move certificated rights onto places now covered by primary irrigation under Permit S-54707. The proposed transfer will also require corresponding changes to Permit S-54707 as requested in this application, including changes in place of use, partial diminution of primary acres to supplemental status and partial cancellation. The water-right transfer and permit amendment only affect the places of use in the NE NE and NW NE of Section 20 in Township 3 South, Range 1 West, WM. The permit amendment/ partial voluntary cancellation proposed in this application are contingent upon approval of the related transfer application, and vice versa.
