Description of Water Delivery System

System capacity: Pump situated on the North side of Grande Ronde pts. 2 and 3 capacity is 2.68 cfs, pump situated on the South side of Grande Ronde pts 2 and 3 is 2.80 cfs cubic feet per second (cfs) OR gallons per minute (gpm)

Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Include information on the pumps, canals, pipelines and sprinklers used to divert, convey and apply the water at the authorized place of use. There is a 75 hp General Electric motor attached to a Cornell centrifugal pump. The pump is attached to a 10" suction line and pushes the water up 15' in height through a 10" buried Steel main. The water pushes North through the 10" main about 300 feet where it turns West and flows 1320 feet to an above ground 8" main. The mains are equipped with risers that connect to 2-5" 1320' long wheel lines, which distribute the water. There is a 100 hp General Electric motor connected to a Cornell centrifugal pump. The pump is attached to a 10" steel suction that raises the water 15 feet into a buried 10" steel main. The main extends South about 800' then reduces to an 8" steel main, buried. The main continues South for 1320 feet and reduces to a 6" buried main. The mainlines have risers that attach to 4 - 5", each 1320' long wheel lines that discribute the water. It would appear to me that both Div pts 2 & 3 are authorized for the certificates.
