*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Permit S-12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Permit S-87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each permit involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the permit (for S-12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be changed to get the application cfs (x 45 ac = 0.56 cfs).
 - b. If the water right permit does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For S-87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Add cfs for the portions of permits on all the land included in the application; however do not count cfs for supplemental permits on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary permit on the same land. Additional remarks: Additional remarks: The distribution of acres by quarter-quarter on the "From" map was generated using the most current and accurate data and corrects erroneously distributed acres on the permit and permit map. The description of acres by quarter-quarter on the "From" map reflects the same description as the permit map but the distribution has been corrected. The footprint of the permit map conforms to the general shapes of the subject tax lot, being 5S 4W TL 200. Additionally, neither Permit G-17338 nor the "From" map describe acres by DLC.
