1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:

- a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac = 0.56 cfs).
- b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Add cfs for the portions of water rights on all the land included in the transfer; however **do not count cfs for supplemental** rights on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary right on the same land. Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application, and why: Water right certificate 72755 allows for the storage of 835,000 acre feet for the purpose of irrigation, being no more than 30,000 acre feet in Cottage Grove Reservoir, 70,000 acre feet in Dorena Reservoir, and 735,000 acre feet in three other reservoirs. This transfer proposes to change the character of use of 437 acre feet of the 100,000 combined acre feet stored in Cottage Grove Reservoir and Dorena Reservoir to municipal and industrial use. This will allow the reservoir operators—the USA Army Corps of Engineers—flexibility to release water stored for municipal and industrial use from one or both reservoirs.
