*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Permit S-12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Permit S-87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each permit involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the permit (for S-12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be changed to get the application cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
 - b. If the water right permit does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For S-87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Add cfs for the portions of permits on all the land included in the application; however do not count cfs for supplemental permits on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary permit on the same land. 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

Additional remarks: <u>The map accompanying this application has been prepared using the best available information and in spite of the poor</u> <u>quality of the existing maps</u>. The basic footprint of the original map available in the Department file appears to conform to the shapes of the <u>subject tax lots (TL 3 3 27 2801 and 2700)</u>. Using improved mapping techniques, including the use of an ortho-rectified aerial photo, and with the addition of DLC location, the section and sixteenth lines are shown to vary somewhat from the original, producing different acreage values per quarter-quarter section but not affecting the overall total acreage. Therefore, the place of use described above, though different from that as described in the permit, represents a re-description, and not a change in, place of use.
