\*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Permit S-12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Permit S-87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each permit involved as follows:
  - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the permit (for S-12345,  $1.25 \text{ cfs} \div 100 \text{ ac}$ ); then multiply by the number of acres to be changed to get the application cfs ( $\times 45 \text{ ac} = 0.56 \text{ cfs}$ ).
  - b. If the water right permit does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For S-87654,  $45.0 \text{ ac} \times 0.0125 \text{ cfs/ac} = 0.56 \text{ cfs}$ )
2. Add cfs for the portions of permits on all the land included in the application; however **do not count cfs for supplemental permits on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary permit on the same land**. The fee should be assessed only once for each "on the ground" acre included in the application. (In this example, blank 5a would be only 0.56 cfs, since both permits serve the same 45.0 acres.
