

The Wallowa Lake State Park water system is one of the components of the WLCSD water distribution system. The POD for the State Park system is the "State Park Spring" POD 1 for reference in this transfer. A 4 inch diameter PVC transmission line transports the water down hill to the State Park campground at a de-aeration facility and the water system flowmeter vault. At the de-aeration facility and flowmeter vault the water is piped in a 6" diameter PVC pipe into the water distribution system that supplies the place of use.
