1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:

- a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs  $\div$ 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
- b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Add cfs for the portions of water rights on all the land included in the transfer; however **do not count cfs for supplemental** rights on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary right on the same land. 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Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application, and why: This application proposes a permanent change in use for App. No. R-41732 / Permit No. R4739 / Certificate No. 51764, adding industrial use to the existing recreation use.

Water will be hauled from the reservoir to be used for hydrostatic testing and dust control during construction of the Pacific Connector Gas Pipeline Project. The total amount of water used for industrial use is approximately 10.18 acre-feet (3,315,584 gallons). The water right certificate for Kinnan Lake allows for storage of up to 395 acre-feet per year.
