*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Certificate 12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Certificate 87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:

- a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac = 0.56 cfs).
- b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Add cfs for the portions of water rights on all the land included in the transfer; however **do not count cfs for supplemental** rights on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary right on the same land. Water is pumped from the authorized well using a 40 Hp submersible pump. The water is then conveyed through a 6" buried PVC mainline that runs east, west, and south. The line reduces to buried 5 " PVC heading north from the 6 inch east-west lines. The 6" line to the south connects to an 8" buried PVC line running east-west and connecting to Well 2 to the east. From these mainlines, the lines go to buried laterals made of PVC with impact sprinklers to irrigate blueberries.


