However, the maps have a place of use identified on them which needs to be clarified. 2) There is an irrigation season within the Ordnance Critical GWA of March 10 <sup>th</sup> - October 15th of each year. The applicant has not expressed a desire to use water year round, however, I suspect that a dairy operation is year round. 3) The application portion related to Certificate 49727 is attempting to transfer the entire rate but has not identified the supplemental portion of the certificate. The "South" well identified on the application map for supplemental use does not appear to be identified on the certificate.
