\*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Permit S-12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Permit S-87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each permit involved as follows:

- a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the permit (for S-12345, 1.25 cfs  $\div$ 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be changed to get the application cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
- b. If the water right permit does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For S-87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

2. Add cfs for the portions of permits on all the land included in the application; however **do not count a** cfs for supplemental permits on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for **b** the primary permit on the same land. The fee should be assessed only once for each "on the

Additional remarks: The permit was originally issued for 27 households with 1/2 acre of irrigation per household as shown on the application map. The subdivision occupies approximately 279 acres and contains 27 approximately 10 acre lots. Although the permit was issued for all 27 lots in the subdivision, not all of the 1/4-1/4 sections in the subdivision were included in the permit. The subdivision contains 27 lots currently numbered 400 through 3000. Lots 400, 1100, 1200, 1300, 1400, 1500, 1600, 1700, 1900, and 2000 are completely outside the 1/4-1/4 sections listed as the place of use in the permit. This permit ammendment is intended to correct the omitted places of use in the permit and to add additional points of appropriation necessary to provide a secure the water supply for the permit holder in the event of mechanical failure and to minimize the drawdown imposed on any one well as a means of protecting both the wells and the aquifer. The permit ammendment does not seek to increas the volume of water permitted or the area intended, the changes to the place of use are only intended to correct an omission in the original permit. The place of use will only include the 27 lots shown on the original permit application and listed under group domestic in the permit.
