^{1.} Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs ± 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac = 0.56 cfs).

^{2.} If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

Description of Water Delivery System

System capacity: 0.8 cubic feet per second (cfs) OR

gallons per minute (gpm)

Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Include information on the pumps, canals, pipelines and sprinklers used to divert, convey and apply the water at the authorized place of use. Water has been diverted using a 30-hp tractor with a PTO pump that has a 4-inch-diameter suction and 3-inch-diameter discharge. There are approximately 3,000 feet of 3-inch-diameter aluminum wheel lines equipped with 75 11/64-inch nozzles operated at about 30 psi. There is also a traveler with 2-inch-diameter hose with 7/16 to 5/8- inch-diameter nozzles operated at 90 psi. The pump is the limiting factor since the available nozzle capacity exceeds that of the pump.
