Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this modification; and why: Consistent with JLR's notice pursuant to ORS 540.520(9) to the Oregon Water Resources Department (the "Department") in October 2012 of its intent to change the authorized specific uses for Certificate Nos. 38969, 38970, 38981, and 40299 from specific to general, JLR now seeks to make Ground Water Registration No. 2218 consistent with these Certificates, by modifying the authorized character of use from specific to general industrial use, and by modifying the authorized place of use. In addition, this application seeks authorization for an additional point of appropriation under Ground Water Registration No. 2218, which would be located approximately 50 feet to the east of the existing point of appropriation and would allow for redunancy. If you need additional space, continue on a separate piece of paper and attach to the application as "Attachment 1". Check this box if this project is fully or partially funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act.
