*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Permit S-12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Permit S-87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each permit involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the permit (for S-12345, $1.25 \text{ cfs} \div 100 \text{ ac}$); then multiply by the number of acres to be changed to get the application cfs ($x 45 \text{ ac} = 0.56 \text{ cfs}$).
 - b. If the water right permit does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For S-87654, $45.0 \text{ ac} \times 0.0125 \text{ cfs/ac} = 0.56 \text{ cfs}$)
2. Add cfs for the portions of permits on all the land included in the application; however **do not count cfs for supplemental permits on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary permit on the same land.** The fee should be assessed only once for each “on the ground” acre included in the application.
