- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
  - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs  $\div$ 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
  - b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Add cfs for the portions of water rights on all the land included in the transfer; however do not count cfs for supplemental rights on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary right on the same land. The fee should be assessed only once for each "on the ground" acre included in the transfer. (In this example, blank 5a would be only 0.56 cfs, since both rights serve the same 45.0 acres. Certificate 90942 includes seven wells at the Vale Airport and Gellerman-Froman Canal. Certificate 90942 contains a total of 5 CFS. This transfer intends to add an APOA, Well 6 (5), POD 5 of Certificate 90942 (26 percent of the total right) to, Well 1, POD 1, Certificate 87397, The Washington Street Well. This Transfer is needed to increse the water available under Certificate 87397 to a total of 2.05 CFS (920 GPM). This transfer is being done in preparation for a Water System Improvements Project that will require the added capacity of Well No. 6 (5), POD 5 of Certificate 90942, 1.30 CFS (583 GPM) to be an APOA to Well No. 1, POD 1, Certificate 87397, The Washington Street Well.

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Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Include information on the pumps, canals, pipelines and sprinklers used to divert, convey and apply the water at the authorized place of use.

Certificate 87397 in the name of the City of Vale is a municipal water right that consists of one well, Well 1, POD 1, locally known as the "Washington Street Well", located at the intersection of Washington St. and 17<sup>th</sup> St. The Washington Street Well was hand-dug in 1912 when the City water system was originally constructed. The well is roughly 16 feet in diameter and 30 feet deep. The well is constructed of reinforced concrete walls and top slab, and has a gravel bottom. The bottom of the concrete casing is perforated 18 inches from the bottom of the well, for a length of 2 feet. The well utilizes a shallow alluvial aquifer.

Well 6 (5), POD 5 for Certificate 90942 is 35' feet deep with a recorded static water level of 6.5 feet based on the data included in Well Log MALH 51524, Attachment "C". Certificate 90942 includes seven wells and is locally known as "The Airport Well Field", the wells, including Well 6 (5), POD 5 were constructed in 2000 as part of a City of Vale water system improvements project. Both wells have water meters at each individual well, and also a master meter in the City's chlorination facility. The wells are also equipped with pressure transducers to read the static and drawdown water levels.

Operation of both wells is controlled by a telemetry and SCADA system, based on an "On Demand" system that remotely monitors the operating level of the City's "Rhinehart" and "Airport" Reservoirs. The remote system activates the pump motor controls to pump water to fill the reservoirs, as needed, based on preset operating levels. Water from the reservoirs then supplies the water distribution system for the entire place of use, the City of Vale water use area, through a system of water transmission and distribution lines.
