Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application; and why:

This Historic Change in Point of Diversion is part of a large-scale habitat restoration project on the Upper Mainstem John Day River. As part of the requirements for the project, water rights in the project footprint need to be updated and proven with the Oregon Water Resources Department. This point of diversion is a single downstream transfer, with no proposed change in amount or priority date. The historic POD has been abandoned for over 10 years, and the actual POD has been in use for over 10 years. The current delivery system of an intake pump and underground pipe delivery system is sufficient for meeting the 7.5 acre shared point of use (three landowners).

Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. The current water delivery system is fed by a single phase 5 horsepower irrigation pump on the mainstem John Day River. A buried 3" irrigation line is run from the pump South, under Hwy 26, to the shared Point of use on Taxlots 500, 400, and 100. Irrigation on the 7.5 acre point of use is through various types of sprinklers and above / below ground lines. As part of the habitat restoration project, Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife will install a new intake screen and suction line to the pump, meeting NOAA fish passage standards.
