
Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application, and why: Farewell Bend Park is irrigated with Central Oregon Irrigation District (COID) water rights that are delivered via an existing pump station at an authorized point of diversion (POD 13) on the east bank of the Deschutes River in Bend's Old Mill District. The Parks District has a pump station and authorized POD 17 that delivers Swalley Irrigation District (SID) to Riverbend Park on the west bank of the Deschutes River in the same general vicinity. The Riverbend Park pump station has the capacity to pressurize water for Farewell Bend Park as well as Riverbend Park. The Parks District would like transfer the Point of Diversion for the COID rights used at Farewell Bend Park to the Riverbend Park POD 17 to better utilize existing district owned pumping facilities and reduce park operating expenses. POD 13 and POD 17 draw from the same pool created behind the Colorado Avenue Dam and there are no other PODs between the subject PODs. New valves and flow meters will be installed immediately outside the Riverbend Pump Station to allow for separate measurement and control of the COID and SID water uses.

The portion of the system that supplies irrigation water for Farewell Bend Park consists of an 8 inch main that feeds into a 6 inch main and then through a meter at the park. From the meter, the water is delivered to 1" and 3" laterals, and is applied through Rainbird sprinklers and drip emitters.**
