SUBJECT: Water Right Transfer Application T-11492

Please find enclosed the Preliminary Determination indicating that, based on the information available, the Department intends to approve application T-11492. This document is an intermediate step in the approval process; water may not be used legally as proposed in the transfer application until a Final Order has been issued by the Department. Please read this entire letter carefully to determine your responsibility for additional action.

A public notice is being published in the Department's weekly publication, simultaneously with issuance of the Preliminary Determination. The notice initiates a period in which any person may file either a protest opposing the decision proposed by the Department in the Preliminary Determination or a standing statement supporting the Department's decision. The protest period will end 30 days after the Department's notice.

If no protest is filed, the Department will issue a Final Order consistent with the Preliminary Determination. You should receive a copy of the Final Order about 30 days after the close of the protest period.

If a protest is filed, the application may be referred to a contested case proceeding. A contested case provides an opportunity for the proponents and opponents of the decision proposed in the Preliminary Determination to present information and arguments supporting their position in a quasi-judicial proceeding.

Authority

ORS 540.505 to 540.580 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

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Findings of Fact

- 1. On November 19, 2012, Signers Riverside Ranch LLC filed an application to change the places of use and points of diversion under Certificates 6959, 52789, and 52791. The Department assigned the application number T-11492.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on December 4, 2012, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On October 25, 2013, the department contacted the agent identifying deficiencies to the transfer application and map.
- 4. On November 26, 2013, the agent submitted a revised transfer application and map.
- 5. On January 29, 2014, the department contacted the agent identifying deficiencies to the transfer application and map.
- 6. On July 10, 2014, the agent submitted a revised transfer application and map.
- 7. On August 20, 2014, the department contacted the applicant identifying deficiencies to the transfer application and map.
- 8. On October 6, 2014, the agent submitted a revised transfer application and map.

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, any person may file a protest or standing statement within 30 days after the last date of publication of notice of this preliminary determination.

- 9. On March 13, 2015, the agent submitted a revised transfer application and map modifying the transfer to change the place of use only.
- 10. On June 2, 2016, the watermaster submitted a revised watermaster review requiring a measuring device on POD 1 only which is further described in finding of fact No. 18.
- 11. On February 2, 2016, the Department sent a copy of the Draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11492 to the applicant. The applicant addressed some issues with the conditions in the Draft Preliminary Determination.
- 12. On June 2, 2016, the Department sent a revised copy of the Draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11492 to the applicant. The applicant's agent requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
- 13. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 6959 in the name of EVA & H. C. LUCE (confirmed by Malheur River

Decree)

Use: IRRIGATION OF 53.5 ACRES

Priority Date: 1902

Limit/Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured

under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-TWENTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1.5 acre feet per acre in any 30 day period prior to June 1st, 1.0 acre foot per acre in any 30 day period after June 1st of each year, or 3.0 acre feet per acre during any season diverted during the irrigation season

of each year.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 20. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 21. A diversion structure and ditch sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-11492.
- 22. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 23. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Determination and Proposed Action

The change in places of use appears to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the transfer application will be approved.

If Transfer Application T-11492 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The change in places of use proposed in Transfer Application T-11492 is approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 6959, 52789, 52791, and any related decree.
- 3. Water right certificate 52789 is cancelled.
- 4. Water right certificates 6959 and 52791 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing those portions of the rights not affected by this transfer.
- 5. The former place of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.
- 6. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. **Before water use may begin** under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at the following point of diversion:

Authorized Point of Diversion, as described on the March 13, 2015 transfer application map and in Water Right Certificate 52791:

- b. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 7. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2017. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
- 8. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
