*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Certificate 12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Certificate 87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:

- a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs +100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).
- b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
- 2. Add cfs for the portions of water rights on all the land included in the transfer; however do not count cfs for supplemental rights on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary right on the same land. The pipe empties into a ditch which flows into Phillip Olson 2B Reservoir via gravity. The water shall be re-pumped from the northwest side of Phillip Olson 2B Reservoir using two 40 HP submersible pumps into existing buried mainlines in a southerly direction across Patty Lane to the proposed Place of Use (POU).

Additional remarks: The entire Place of Use (POU) of certificate 91708 is being transferred. Portions of the proposed POU already have a primary right being certificate 33665. Because this certificate has far less volume than is needed for the intended irrigation purpose (9.0

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acre-feet for 80 acres of irrigation), this transfer is to add an additional primary right to those lands and NOT make the right being transferred a supplemental right.

Also, No Land Use Compatibility Statement is needed because all of the following apply: a) a change in place of use only, b) no structural changes, c) the use of water is for irrigation only, and d) the use is located within an irrigation district or an exclusive farm use zone.

Note: Because certificate 33666 has only 9.0 acre-feet (AF) of volume (from certificate 33665 – Olson Reservoir) for irrigating 80 acres and 9.0 AF is far less than the normal maximum for irrigation which is 200 AF (= 2.5 ac-ft/ac x 80 ac), this transfer shall keep the primary right status of certificate 91708 for the entire proposed POU.
