On behalf of Chris and Joan Horton, I am submitting the enclosed Application for a Water Right Temporary Transfer for Certificate 26611. The Temporary Transfer Application requests to temporarily change the place of use and point of diversion for Certificate 26611. The proposed point of diversion is an existing diversion located downstream of the authorized point of diversion. The requested time period for this temporary transfer is five years (terminating at the end of the 2021 irrigation season).

Certificate 26611 is appurtenant to property owned by the Marjorie Robertson Living Trust. Marjorie Robertson is the trustee for the trust. Janet E. 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

The system includes a 10 hp Berkely pump, however water has been applied using a PTO pump for several years because the site of the electric pump has been washed out and requires a new pump site set-up. Currently, a Rainmaster PTO 6" pump connects to one 58 pc 4"x40' mainline and one 21 pc 3"x40' mainline, which connects to 21 pc 3"x40' laterals with rainbird sprinklers that deliver 7 gpm.
