Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. The current water delivery system is fed by a single phase 5 horsepower irrigation pump on the mainstem John Day River. A buried 3” irrigation line is run from the pump South, under Hwy 26, to the shared Point of use on Taxlots 500, 400, and 100. 0.55 Acres of the POU will be a remaining right, with all occurring on taxlot 1900. Irrigation on the 6.95 acre point of use is through various types of sprinklers and above / below ground lines. As part of the habitat restoration project, Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife will install a new intake screen and suction line to the pump, meeting NOAA fish passage standards.
