Dear Mr. Van Voorhees:

On November 20, 1978, we received from you water right transfer applications, in the name of Ned Severance, proposing an exchange of priorities between two water rights; one for Beaver Creek, the other for South Fork Crooked River. Since the proposed changes would result in a change in source of water under each of the rights, the applications could not be considered for approval by the State Engineer and, therefore, could not be legally filed.

The two pending applications are returned herewith, together with our refund check No. 2419, in the amount of \$34.65.

Mr. Jones of this office wrote to you on this matter on April 17, 1974. I do not know why the applications were not returned to you and the fees refunded at that time.
