Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Include information on the pumps, canals, pipelines and sprinklers used to divert, convey and apply the water at the authorized place of use. The existing well was drilled in 1952. The well is 122 feet deep and has a 10" casing. There is a Berkeley 40 hp pump (SN # 7625880) with a 40 hp motor (U.S. Electric Motor—SN 9509-00-D590). As an alternative source of power, a Detroit Diesel is also connected to the pump. An 8" diameter PVC pipe is buried that connects the pump to the center of the farmed field. The farm field is irrigated with a well line using 6" diameter aluminum pipe.
