

This letter is an attachment to the Laurelwood Water Users Co-operative transfer application for Certificate 2879.

1. Regarding amount to be transferred:

The original certificate was for 1.00 cfs for irrigation, domestic supply and power generation. The power claim was cancelled as noted on the permit abstract.

The full rate for irrigation of 25 acres would be 0.3125 cfs, leaving 0.6875 cfs for domestic supply.

Using the head available as stated on the certificate, and as verified from the USGS quad sheet, my computations show that it is only possible to get 0.881 cfs through the 4"-diameter steel supply pipe line.

Using the 0.881 cfs as a basis and subtracting the 0.3125 cfs for irrigation leaves 0.568 cfs available to transfer from domestic supply to quasi-municipal use.

A computation sheet for the pipe calculations is attached.

2. Regarding the mapping:

Two maps are enclosed. I believe that the 11"x17" map with USGS quad sheet base is adequate for the transfer process. A second map, 24"x36" in size is also included. Although it probably is adequate, it may have too much detail for your use. Please use the map that best suits your needs.

3. During the transfer process it became apparent that the mapped location of the spring for certificate 2879 is in error. When plotted it lands outside the tax lot that actually contains the spring. (see large map)

At your request, I visited the spring site with Mr. Gary Carr from the Cooperative. The spring has been developed and is within a chain link fence enclosure. It obviously has been at this location for a long time. There is no spring at the certificate map location.


