RE: Alternate pumping site

Dear Jon,

We, the Palmer Creek Water District Board of Directors, want to thank you for taking the time and extra step of seeking written approval of your intent to develop an alternative pumping site to support your irrigation needs. In our research and as you mentioned in your request, the district did grant the privilege to another member that had acreage in the district but wanted to supply water from a diversion point other than the district's present pumping station. In a letter to member Wil Wilson, dated August 6, 1990 and meeting minutes from August 7, 1990, the following policy was motioned to the board and passed:

- Members with acreage included in the district, but being supplied water from a different source, would have the same rights and responsibilities as acreage presently being supplied water by the Districts pumping station. In addition this acreage would be subject to the same policies and regulations that all of the other acres in the District are subject to. This acreage would also be subject to all assessments that are presently being assessed on acreage for the payment of capitol charges, and any assessments for new improvements, but would not include charges for water acre-feet that are assessed members for the cost of providing water to their individual pumping sites.
- 2. If the districts water rights are regulated by the Water Resources Department, or other regulatory agencies, for reasons of water shortage or other regulatory actions; members with acreage having a diversion point other than the Districts would be required to comply with the same policies or regulations as the other members.

3. Members having acreage with a diversion point other than the Districts' will be required to install metering devices to measure water.

In granting your request to develop an alternative diversion point, the board would ask that you adhere to the above policy. The board also appreciates your willingness to use this alternative site to provide support to the overall system.

- *Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Permit S-12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Permit S-87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:
- 1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each permit involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the permit (for S-12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be changed to get the application cfs (x 45 ac = 0.56 cfs).
 - b. If the water right permit does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For S-87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
