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



CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That city of Newberg

of Newberg , State of Oregon . , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Atkinson Spring, a tributary of Chehalem Creek
a tributary of "illamette River for the purpose of Municipal purposes
under Permit No. 6530 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from July 10, 1923;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

2.0 cubic feet per second;

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appartenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SESSE) of Section Twenty (20). Township Three South, Range Two West of the Willamette Leridian, in Yamill County, Oregon.

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The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby contirmed and limited.




