1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:

a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).

b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

East Side Ditch will no longer be used to convey water to the authorized 15 acres. Pond No. 1 of the Notice of Exempt Reservoir No. P-74225 will be filled by pumping from proposed POD 1 and the ditches from this pond will continue to be used to flood irrigate the POU shown on the attached map. This water right overlaps the POU for C-85690 by 10.3 acres, 2.9 acres will be transferred from the SWNW to the NWNW of Section 11 and 7.4 acres will remain in the SWNW but will be diminished to supplemental irrigation.
