*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Certificate 12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Certificate 87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:

a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac = 0.56 cfs).

b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

2. Add cfs for the portions of water rights on all the land included in the transfer; however do not count cfs for supplemental rights on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary right on the same land. Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this transfer application, and why: Since T-9812 and T-8741 were submitted and completed, a channel of the Willamette River has shifted and now the bank is actively eroding where the POD is currently located for all the surface water rights involved in T-8741. At this time, there is no a good place on the bank to move the POD and get away from the erosion problem. However, the POD can be used on a temporary basis. Therefore, a substitution is proposed to use existing groundwater rights changed through T-9812 as primary and make the surface water supplemental.


