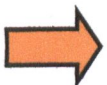
Explain in your own words what you propose to accomplish with this modification; and why:
It is proposed to add POA 3 and POA 7 as APOAs for GR-1377 for more efficient irrigation and as insurance for the ability to irrigate if the currently authorized POA 4 should become inoperable. It is also proposed to move that portion of GR-1377 on buildings and driveways to tillable land. Please note that in OWRD files for GR-1377 and certificate 40094, there is documentation correcting the foot print of GR-1377 and the location of the authorized POA which we are calling POA 4. Our attached map shows GR-1377 and POA 4 in their corrected locations.

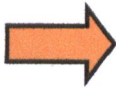
