Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. The water is conveyed from the POD on Crabtree Creek in an unlined ditch that serves a number of water rights in the area. The ditch is at least 5-feet wide and at least 3-feet deep at the rediversion point.

The water can be rediverted from the ditch to irrigate Certificate 43483 and other water rights on the property using a 60-hp electric centrifugal pump. The water can be conveyed to the places of use by over 2,000 feet of 6 and 8-inch-diameter aluminum mainline pipe. There are over 6,000 feet of 3-inch-diameter aluminum hand lines and more than 200 #30 Rainbird sprinklers that deliver 7 gpm at 50 psi.

The lift from the ditch to the pump is less than 5 feet and the lowest point of the place of use is approximately the level of the pump. The WRD online pump calculator available to CWREs indicates the pump can produce 3.0 cfs when operated at 50 psi. The use of 195 sprinklers would deliver 3.0 cfs.



Exhibit A to Evidence of Use

The Applicant purchased the property with the subject water rights (Certificates 43483 and 55945) from a bank in 2014.

The attached June 23, 2009 Evidence of Use Map indicates that the water rights were fully exercised during the 2009 irrigation season.

The Applicant does not have information relating to water use during the irrigation seasons of 2010 through 2013. However, the property was bank owned during a significant portion of that time and foreclosure proceedings are considered an economic hardship under ORS 540.610(2)(d) and related administrative rules. This is one basis for rebuttal of any presumption of forfeiture.


In 2014 and 2015, the Applicant raised grass seed on the property covered by Certificates 43483 and 55945. Water was not needed for the grass seed. This is another basis for rebuttal of any presumption of forfeiture. The non-use of water occurred during a period of time within which the exercise of all or a part of the water right was not necessary due to climatic conditions, and the water right holder/Applicant had a facility capable of handling the full allowed rate and duty and was otherwise ready, willing and able to use the entire amount of water allowed under the water right. ORS 540.610(2)(L).

Taken together, the above evidence and applicable excuses in ORS 540.610 demonstrate that water rights proposed for transfer are not subject to forfeiture and any presumption of forfeiture would be rebutted.




