## Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

ORS 540.510 authorizes the Department to cancel a supplemental water right or permit, or portion thereof, if the applicant does not include the supplemental water right in the transfer application.

## **Applicant**

## **Findings of Fact**

- 1. On October 7, 2015, Aspen Valley Ranch, LLC. filed an application to change the point of diversion and to change the place of use under Certificates 571 and 81327. The Department assigned the application number T-12178.
- 2. On December 21, 2016, the Department informed the applicant's agent, by written correspondence, of deficiencies in the application. The Department requested that the deficiencies be resolved by February 17, 2017. The applicant agent met with staff to resolve the map issues on February 16, 2017. The information necessary to resolve the remaining deficiencies was received on March 13, 2017.
- 3. On March 13, 2017, the applicant submitted authorization for the voluntary partial cancellation of water right permit S-29082 for supplemental irrigation from the Sherwood Creek Reservoir.

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, any person may file a protest or standing statement within 30 days after the last date of publication of notice of this preliminary determination.

- 4. Notice of the application for transfer was published on October 13, 2015, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 5. On April 19, 2017, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-12178 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of May 19, 2017, for the applicant to respond. On May 11, 2017, the applicant requested the deadline be extended to September 19, 2017.
- 6. On November 13, 2017, the Applicant provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
- 7. On December 22, 2017, the Department received a request from the applicant's agent, requesting to withdraw Certificate 543 from transfer application T-12178. Certificate 543 has been removed from this transfer application.
- 8. On February 16, 2018, the Department mailed a copy of the revised draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-12178 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of March 19, 2018, for the applicant to respond.
- 9. On March 15, 2018, the applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination.
- 10. On March 20, 2018, the Department sent a letter to the applicant providing clarification on the sequence of events leading up to the termination of temporary transfer application T-12339 prior to the issuance of a Final Order for T-12178.
- 11. On April 2, 2018, the Department received a written request from the applicant to terminate temporary transfer application T-12339 for Certificates 571 and 81327 upon issuance of a Final Order for transfer application T-12178.

- 20. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife has determined that a fish screen is necessary at the new points of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversions and that the diversions are not currently equipped with an appropriate fish screen. This diversion may be eligible for screening cost-share funds.
- 21. There is an existing supplemental water right permit, S-29082, appurtenant to the portion of lands in which Certificate 81327 is proposed to be transferred. The applicant has requested that affected portions of the supplemental water right permit be cancelled upon issuance of a Final Order approving T-12178

## Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 22. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 23. A diversion structure and ditch sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-12178.
- 24. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 25. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 26. All other application requirements are met.

## Partial Cancellation of a Water Right Permit

- 27. There is an existing supplemental water right permit, S-29082, appurtenant to the portion of lands on which Certificate 81327 is proposed to be transferred. The applicant has requested that affected portions of the supplemental water right permit be cancelled upon issuance of the Final Order approving T-12178.
- 28. The portion of the water right permit to be cancelled is as follows:

## **Determination and Proposed Action**

The changes in points of diversion and places of use proposed in Transfer Application T-12178 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the transfer application will be approved.

*If Transfer Application T-12178 is approved, the final order will include the following:* 

- 1. The changes in points of diversion and places of use proposed in Transfer Application *T-12178* are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 571, 81327, and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificates 571 and 81327 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing the portion of the rights not affected by this transfer.
- 4. The portion of Water Right Permit S-29082 described above is cancelled, and a superseding permit will be issued.
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.
- 6. Water use measurement conditions:
  - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion.
  - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.

- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 7. Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install an approved fish screen at the new points of diversion and shall provide to the OWRD a written statement from Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) that the installed screens meet the state's criteria, or that ODFW has determined a screen is not necessary.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new points of diversion consistent with ODFW's operation and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screens are not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screens are functioning properly.

- 8. The former place of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.
- 9. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2019**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 10. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred.
