1. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).

2. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. There is a 75 hp General Electric motor attached to a Cornell centrifugal pump that raises the water through a 10" steel suction that raises the water 10' into a buried 10" steel main. The main extends South 1800' then reduces to an 8" steel main and extends South for another 1500'. There are risers that attach to 4-5", each 1320 long wheel lines that distrubute the water on the lands in Section 2. There are also risers that attach to 3-5" wheel lines. two of the lines are 1320' long and one wheel line is 2600' long. These wheel lines have been watering the rights on these lands for a number of years.
