# **Authority**

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

## **Applicant**

FRYER CREEK RANCH LLC 40791 SE SHOTGUN RD POST, OR 97752

## **Findings of Fact**

- 1. On February 8, 2018, FRYER CREEK RANCH LLC filed an application for additional points of appropriation and to change the place of use under Certificates 87791, 87793, and 93545. The Department assigned the application number T-12841.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on February 13, 2018, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On March 16, 2018, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-12841 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of April 16, 2018, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department extend the completion date to October 1, 2021 and to proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination. The applicant provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, any person may file a protest or standing statement within 30 days after the last date of publication of notice of this preliminary determination.

## Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

13. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.

- 14. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-12841.
- 15. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 16. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 17. All other application requirements are met.

## **Determination and Proposed Action**

The additional points of appropriation and change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-12841 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the application will be approved.

If Transfer Application T-1284 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The additional points of appropriation and change in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-12841 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 87791, 87793, and 93545 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificates 87791, 87793, and 93545 are cancelled.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
- 5. Water use measurement conditions:
  - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each new point of appropriation.
  - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
  - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 6. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
- 7. The former place of use of the transferred right shall no longer receive water under the right.

- 8. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2021**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 9. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
