Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of diversion, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On January 19, 2016, Cunningham Sheep Co. filed an application to change the points of diversion and to change the place of use under Certificates 2484, 28608, 87710, and 87711. All are layered with supplemental water Permit S-7400. The Department assigned the application number T-12252.
- 2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on January 26, 2016, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 3. On December 10, 14, 15, 18, and 21, 2017, the agent for the applicant submitted new revised applications to clarify the authorized and proposed points of diversion under several water rights.
- 4. On December 22, 2017, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-12252 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of January 21, 2018, for the applicant to respond. On January 4, 2018, the agent for the applicant requested the Department proceed with issuance of the Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.

Pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, any person may file a protest or standing statement within 30 days after the last date of publication of notice of this preliminary determination.

5. On January 29, 2018, the applicant's agent submitted an amended application clarifying the proposed points of diversion for Certificates 87710 and 87711, along with the supplemental right under Permit S-7400.

20. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has determined that a fish screening and/or by-pass device is necessary at the new point of diversion to prevent fish from entering the diversion and/or safely transport fish back to the body of water from which the fish were diverted and that the diversion is not currently equipped with an appropriate fish screening and/or by-pass device. This diversion may be eligible for screening cost share funds.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

- 21. Water has been used within the five-year period prior to submittal of the transfer application according to the terms and conditions of the right. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 22. Pumping structures, pumps, pipeline, wheel lines and sprinkler systems sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-12252.
- 23. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 24. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.

Determination and Proposed Action

The changes in points of diversion, additional points of diversion, and changes in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-12252 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000. If protests are not filed pursuant to OAR 690-380-4030, the transfer application will be approved.

If Transfer Application T-12252 is approved, the final order will include the following:

- 1. The changes in points of diversion, additional points of diversion and changes in place of use proposed in Transfer Application T-12252 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 2484, 28608, 87710, and 87711 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right Certificates 2484, 28608, 87710, and 87711 are cancelled. Permit 7400 is modified; the Department will issue a superseding permit describing the portions transferred when it is determined that it is necessary for record keeping.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of diversion, together with that diverted at the original points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.
- 5. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- 6. Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the new point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's (ODFW) design and construction standards. Prior to installation, the water user shall obtain written approval from ODFW that the required screen and/or by-pass device meets ODFW's criteria. Prior to submitting a Claim of Beneficial Use, the water user must obtain written approval from ODFW that the required screening and/or by-pass device was installed to the state's criteria. The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screens and/or by-pass devices, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards.
- 7. The former places of use of the transferred rights shall no longer receive water under the rights.
- 8. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2019**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.

9. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
