^{2.} If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac $\times 0.0125$ cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

The greenhouses in the southern end are irrigated with impact sprinklers supplied by Well 1 (MARI 3944) using s 20 Hp submersible pump to convey water through a six-inch mainline. The fields are irrigated by Well 2 using a 40 Hp turbine pump conveyed through a six-inch mainline with hydrants where portable handlines with impact sprinklers or a hose reel can be attached.
