CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHARLES R. NEWTON, *et al.*

CORVALLIS, OR 97330

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL No. 2 in the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 7.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6407. The date of priority is MARCH 31, 1975. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year for a total annual volume of 19.0 acre-feet, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate, together with Certificate 93802 and the conserved water under CW-97, supersedes Certificate 48577.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the

provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
