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Additional remarks: For the "from" lands the existing Cherry Orchard with trees planted on 18' rows. A 6' wide strip will be irrigated and a 12' strip will be taken out of irrigation to move to the new orchard.

For the proposed "to" lands the Apple Orchard (*) will be a 5' wide irrigated strip and a 7' wide non-irrigated strip or 41.7% irrigated, and the Cherry Orchard (^) will be a 6' wide irrigated strip and a 10' wide non-irrigated strip or 37.5% irrigated.

This temporary transfer is to bridge until Application G-18285 can be resolved and the permit issued.
