

Hello, I am the property owner, we purchased this land and home in 2015 and were misinformed of how many old water rights and where they were. Susan was very understanding at the time. To us it was shocking since it was a large part of the decision in the purchase of the property. We should not have trusted the many entities we did that had told us the information, lesson learned. This property has always been income producing property from produce, hay production, orchards to various markets and completely organic for the past 25 years. The vast majority of income crops of rotation was another large decision in the purchase. With all of that being said the crops are the entire income we have coming in for our family and this farm, so when hearing that there was a solution of transferring some of our old water rights during the drought to one of our crop fields that has new water rights made us feel relieved. Not that we have to go thru all of the paperwork etc...but satisfied there is a solution. We will make no structure changes, no changes to POD, only to the new location of POU. Our old water rights is for 8 acres and we will use partial use of 3 acres of that temporarily for the drought season until we can establish a more permanent idea going forward with the proper application in the fall.

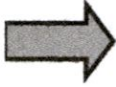
