*Example for Line 5a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Certificate 12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Certificate 87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:

a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs \div 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).

b. If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)

2. Add cfs for the portions of water rights on all the land included in the transfer; however do not count cfs for supplemental rights on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary right on the same land. Hot water is discharged to Hot Lake from spring 4. The water is pumped out of Hot Lake and distributed through the RV park's irrigation system. Water from Spring 4 is also pumped from the spring back to the RV park for use in the resort. The pipeline system is shown on the transfer maps.

Additional remarks: Currently there are 20.6 acres of the 145.3 acres in Certificate 34636 that are irrigated by Grande Hot Springs from Springs 1, 2 and 4 on tax lot 801. At a rate of 1/40th this is 0.52 CFS. In proportion to the entire right this is: 0.04 CFS from spring 1, 0.08 CFS from spring 2, and 0.40 CFS from spring 4. In this transfer Mr. Rysavy is proposing to change the COU of 7.6 acres (0.19 CFS) from irrigation to commercial/recreational. The 0.19 CFS will come entirely from spring 4.

The result of the transfer will be 13 acres irrigated with 0.04 CFS from spring 1, 0.08 CFS from spring 2 and 0.21 CFS from spring 4. 0.19

CFS from spring 4 will be used for commercial/recreational purposes.
