1. For irrigation calculate cfs for each water right involved as follows:
 - a. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, $1.25 \text{ cfs} \div 100 \text{ ac}$); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs ($\times 45 \text{ ac} = 0.56 \text{ cfs}$).

Description of Water Delivery System

System capacity: 0.97 cubic feet per second (cfs) OR

Describe the current water delivery system or the system that was in place at some time within the last five years. Include information on the pumps, canals, pipelines, and sprinklers used to divert, convey, and apply the water at the authorized place of use. Water is diverted from the South Yamhill River using a 40-hp centrifugal pump. The water is conveyed to the places of use via a 6 inch and 8-inch-diameter mainline. The water is applied using a traveler with a big gun and hand lines. The nozzle on the big gun is 1.3 inches. The handlines have 9/64-inch nozzles. There are approximately 120 nozzles available.

The lift from the river to the pump is approximately 8 feet and the lift from the pump to the lowest point of the field is estimated to be a maximum of 10 feet. The pump operates at approximately 100 psi and delivers about 50 to 60 psi to the irrigation equipment.

The WRD's online pump capacity calculator available to CWREs indicates the pump can produce 0.97 cfs. Tables available for Nelson Big Gun Sprinklers indicate a 1.3-inch nozzle can deliver 350 gpm (0.78 cfs) at 50 psi. The 9/64-inch nozzles each deliver 4 gpm at 50 psi according to a table attached to the CWRE Claim of Beneficial Use form; 120 nozzles could deliver 480 gpm (1.07 cfs). The use of the Big Gun and some 9/64-inch nozzles could deliver the 0.97 cfs diverted by the pump.

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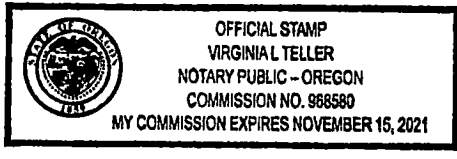

GROWER AGREES:

- To plant stock furnished by the Company in the proper season of 2015 at a rate of — per acre, for harvest in 2015.
- Grower agrees that he will not plant any of the stockseed supplied hereunder within a minimum of 1 mile(s) unless specified under "Other Conditions" of any other crop of the same species, whether grown by the Grower or by any other person unless he shall first obtain the written consent of the Company. **Grower agrees that it is his responsibility that the isolation requirements described herein are met at planting time and are maintained throughout the production cycle of the crop.**
- Grower warrants that the land to be used for seed production hereunder was previously used as follows:

- Grower further agrees to cultivate and care for the growing crop and to keep it free of weeds and weed seeds; to make such examinations and eliminations reasonably necessary to keep the crop for seed purposes; to harvest, cure, separate and clean, with appropriate machinery, the seed product as to secure the greatest possible return of seed for Company's use; and to deliver the seed f.o.b. as directed by Company without wasting, feeding, selling or reserving any portion of the crop, stockseed, plants, bulbs or roots furnished, or allowing the same to pass from Grower's possession; to reimburse Company for any loss or damage to bins or seed sheets not returned in good condition with the crop, and if the crop is grown from bulbs or roots, to destroy all remaining after the crop is planted.
- If, in the opinion of the Company, the seed crop so delivered by the Grower has been mixed with other varieties of similar seed, or if its identity is lost, or if there is an excess of foreign matter, or if it shall in any respect be unfit for sale as seed, or if an undue amount of milling, recleaning, or hand picking shall be required, or if the crops are in any other respect unfit for shipment because of insect, noxious or undesirable weed, disease infestation, fail to pass phytosanitary, or do not meet the quality standards of this contract in any way, the Company shall have the privilege to reject such seed crop or any part thereof, and the determination by the Company of any of those facts shall be binding upon the parties hereto; and in the event the Company shall be under no obligation to pay the Grower any sum whatsoever for his services or for the use of said real estate in growing said seed crop.
- The lands for which crop herein described are either owned or leased by Grower. Should Grower lose possession of the land, Grower will compensate Company for the market value of the crop.
- Grower shall bear the risk of loss to the crop hereunder at all times until such seed crop has been accepted by Company. In other words, Grower's sole right to compensation hereunder shall be based only upon the production of an acceptable seed crop.
