

The purpose of this transfer is to convert existing Port Columbia River Irrigation rights to Municipal Use. Pertinent details of the Transfer are as follows:

- 1) The Port request the Transferred Use to remain within the Certificate Authorized Irrigation Season of March 1 through October 31.
- 2) The Port Requests that the Rate and Duty remain unchanged according to the prorated acreages under Port Ownership as documented in the Transfer Application.
- 3) A Temporary Transfer exists for portions of these same acreages, T-12587. The Special Order Volume 104, Page 258 authorized the Temporary Transfer through the 2020 Irrigation Season. The Port Requests that once the Preliminary Determination is made to allow this Permanent Transfer, The Port be notified and the Port will formally notify the Department and Cancel T-12587 such that the Permanent Transfer Order may be issued.
