Re: Measurement and Reporting for Split Season Lease

Salem, OR

For 94163 the duty is 1.5 acre-foot per acre for every 30-day period from May 1-July 31, and 1 acre-foot per acre for all of August 1- September 31. Because the instream period for the proposed split season lease begins on August 1 and ends on September 31, and because the irrigation duty limitation for August 1 - September 31 is independent of irrigation duty usage from May 1- July 31, the water master is not requiring measuring devices to monitor duty usage from May 1- July 31 for these water rights. Compliance with the terms of the split season lease and confirmation that no irrigation water is being applied to acres involved in the proposed split season lease from August 1- September 31 will be confirmed by regular site visits by the water master and The Freshwater Trust staff.

The remaining water right involved in the split season lease (certificate 94150) has both rate and duty limitations uniformly defined across the entire May 1- September 31 irrigation season. As such, the water master is requiring measuring devices to monitor irrigation water usage from May 1- July 31 in order to prevent injury. The monitoring requirements for these water rights are further defined in the attached split season lease application.
