



Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

Any use of water under this right beyond 18.54 cfs is subject to the fish persistence conditions as identified in the Final Order for Extension of Time for Permit S-49497 entered August 24, 2012, at Special Order Volume 101, Page 153. The conditions to maintain the persistence of listed fish will not have an impact on the use of water under this certificate.

The right granted herein is limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 39.8 CFS measured at the point of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from the Columbia River.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued for a partial perfection of Permit S-49497 as described in OAR 690-320-0040 and by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 17, 2019 at Special Order Volume 112, Pages 284 - 285.
