\*Example for Line 2a calculation to transfer 45.0 acres of Primary Certificate 12345 (total 1.25 cfs for 100 acres) and 45.0 acres of Supplemental Certificate 87654 (1/80 cfs per acre) on the same land:

1. Divide total authorized cfs by total acres in the water right (for C12345, 1.25 cfs  $\div$ 100 ac); then multiply by the number of acres to be transferred to get the transfer cfs (x 45 ac= 0.56 cfs).

If the water right certificate does not list total cfs, but identifies the allowable use as 1/40 or 1/80 of a cfs per acre; multiply number of acres proposed for change by either 0.025 (1/40) or 0.0125 (1/80). (For C87654, 45.0 ac x 0.0125 cfs/ac = 0.56 cfs)
 Add cfs for the portions of water rights on all the land included in the transfer; however do not count cfs for supplemental rights on acreage for which you have already calculated the cfs fee for the primary right on the same land. The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife is submitting this letter of support for Mr. Tobin's temporary water right point of use and diversion transfer application. The transfer will move a POD/POU from an open ditch system downstream to a screened irrigation pump on the South Fork John Day River. The new POU is located in Grant Count T13S, R27E – Section 6.

The temporary transfer is expected to enhance stream flow conditions in this reach of the lower South Fork John Day River by moving the POD downstream and changing irrigation methods from flood to a pump sprinkler system on POU ground better served by a pump system. The transfer is expected to provide benefits for both water user and fish species present in the South Fork.

ODFW believes that this application will provide a benefit to federally listed steelhead and other native resident fish species in the South Fork John Day River. Improving fish rearing habitat and stream flow quantity and quality is a priority for ODFW. We recommend that the Water Resources Department consider reducing application fees for Mr. Tobin that are associated with the POD/POU transfer. We will review the application as it proceeds through the inter-agency review process.
