The Director may require the water user to obtain and report additional water levels each year if more data are needed to evaluate the aquifer system.

The water user shall discontinue use of, or reduce the rate or volume of withdrawal from, the well(s) if any of the following events occur:

- (A) Annual water-level measurements reveal an average water-level decline of three or more feet per year for five consecutive years; or
- (B) Annual water-level measurements reveal a water-level decline of 15 or more feet in fewer than five consecutive years; or
- (C) Annual water-level measurements reveal a water-level decline of 25 or more feet; or
- (D) Hydraulic interference leads to a decline of 25 or more feet in any neighboring well with senior priority.

The period of restricted use shall continue until the water level rises above the decline level which triggered the action or until the Department determines, based on the water user's and/or the Department's data and analysis, that no action is necessary because the aquifer in question can sustain the observed declines without adversely impacting the resource or causing substantial interference with senior water rights. The water user shall not allow excessive decline, as defined in Commission rules, to occur within the aquifer as a result of use under this right. If more than one well is involved, the water user may submit an alternative measurement and reporting plan for review and approval by the Department.

The water user shall ensure that the wells have been assigned an OWRD Well Identification Number (Well ID tag), which shall be permanently attached to each well. The Well IDs shall be used as a reference in any correspondence regarding the wells, including any reports of water use, water level, or pump test data.

The combined quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (Well 6), together with that diverted at the old points of appropriation (Well 1, Well 3, Well 4, and Well 5), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this right, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interference.

The well(s) shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The use may be restricted if the quality of downstream waters decreases to the point that those waters no longer meet existing state or federal water quality standards due to reduced flows.
