Additional remarks: The purpose of this transfer is to evaluate the potential for CBD oil production and marketing as an industry for the Klamath Tribe. This location provides store frontage to Hwy 97, which is critical to the business plan. The transfer is from the Wood River watershed to the Williamson River watershed. We justify this by both rivers ultimately feed Upper Klamath Lake. The existing POA is from a shallow well less than ¾ mile from surface water. The proposed additional POA for the 7.0 acres being transferred is taking water from a much deeper source and is about 1.5 miles from surface water. See attached letter from Watermaster.
